While Birth of a Nation was not without controversy, they were able to host more than 80 in attendance. Not only did they sell out two theatres with more than 645 tickets, they also drew local attention through local news outlets and drew national attention when Janelle Monae posted a picture of them on her Instagram yielding more than 10,000 likes!
